You almost certainly know about The National Trust and that its members get free entry to its properties, but you may not know that there are also “supporters’ Clubs” throughout the country. These are called “Centres” or “Associations” and consist of members of the Trust who want to do more than simply visit the properties. The Croydon and District Centre is one of these and has a programme of **talks, outings, holidays** and **social events**, all designed to promote and prosper the work of the Trust – and for the enjoyment of our members.

TALKS From October to March inclusive we have meetings on the Third Wednesday of the month at Shirley Parish Hall Wickham Road Shirley, starting with a cup of coffee at 2.00 p.m. and comprising illustrated talks on a wide range of subjects. These talks, which start at 2.30 p.m. are open to non-members so you are welcome to come any time you wish (there is an entrance charge).

OUTINGS Throughout the year we run coach excursions to places of interest. Whilst many of these are to National Trust properties visits are made to gardens, properties and exhibitions not in the ownership of the trust.

HOLIDAYS There is usually the opportunity to join with other groups for a holiday in England or Wales with a varied and interesting programme and staying at good class hotels.

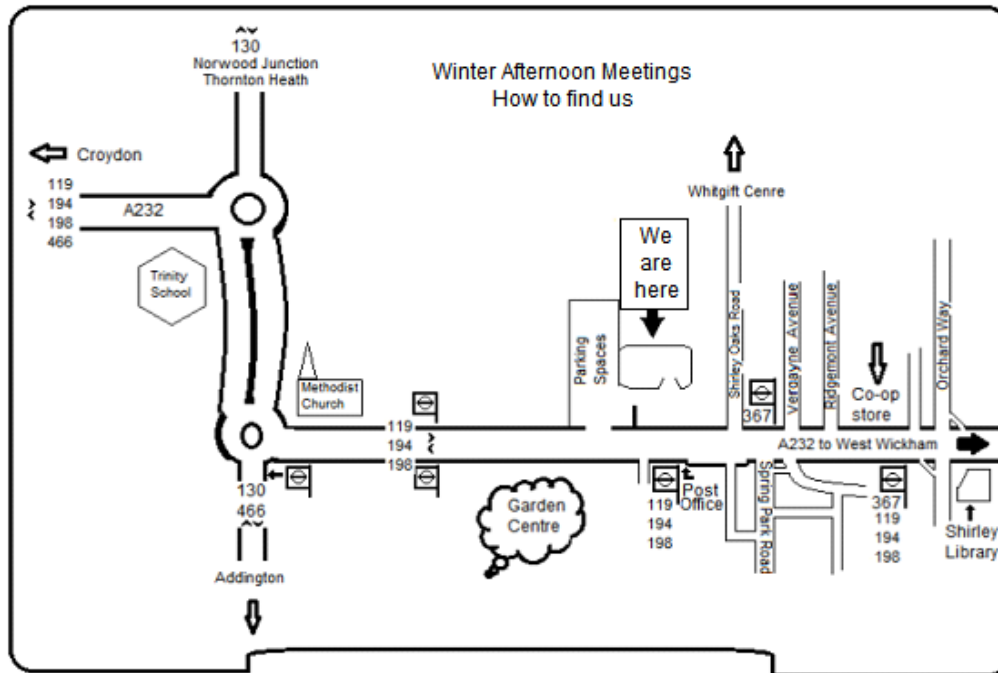
SOCIAL EVENTS There are a variety of lunches and other social events throughout the year which are not only good fun but raise funds for the National Trust!
